SAILING ACTIVITIES

Yacht and dinghy racing, in the form of Points Series, takes place on Saturday afternoons and Wednesday evenings. Starts and courses are provided for cruiser handicap racing (Portsmouth Yardstick Scheme), Leisure 17 class racing and dinghy handicap racing (PYS) including Wayfarers and Toppers. Refreshments are available after racing from the bar.

From time to time the Club hosts important open events for both cruisers and dinghies. There is also a full programme of annual regattas and other open events elsewhere on the Lough, including our own regatta, at which EDYC Members compete.

Many Members also sail their boats in a more leisurely and informal manner at other times, including cruising around the Lough and further afield, or just rafting-up on the pontoon.

East Down Yacht Club is a Royal Yachting Association Recognised Training Establishment and regularly organises training courses involving full RYA certificated instructors and examiners.

East Down Yacht Club is mainly a self help club. Members are expected to assist with the running of the Club. To this end, rotas for race duties are published by the Sailing Captain and for tea making and bar duties (after racing) by the House Captain. Also, work parties are arranged from time to time, and members are requested to report to the session organisers and to contribute actively in any session.

As well as complying with the Rules of the Club, Members are expected to observe notices issued by Committees, particularly with regard to personal safety, car and boat parking, and to avoid causing obstruction to others.
