Event Guidelines

Sailing Instructions

Each host club is responsible for producing sailing instructions for their round of the series.

Sailing instructions should be available on the day of the event. Host clubs may also make S.I.s via their website, if applicable.

Registration

Registration is free; boats should be registered in advance using the appropriate form. Completed forms should be forwarded to David Thompson, 35 Lombard Avenue, Lisburn BT28 2UP. Details of boat, i.e. class, club, sail no. and helm, may also be sent by e-mail to djthompson@bigfoot.com.

Please try to register boats before 10th May

Boats may be registered on the day of each round, by giving the details in writing to the race officer at the briefing. The boat should be added to the register for future events, but it is the competitor's responsibility to check. The register will be available for inspection at www.killyleaghyachtclub.com.

Race officers should forward any, on the day registrations, with the results, to David Thompson contact details above.

Scoring and Prizes.

Prizes will be awarded for 1st place in each class at each event. Host clubs may provide other prizes at their discretion.

Series prizes will be awarded for each class using the low points system.

If all events are run competitors will have 1 discard.

If possible results to date will be posted at each event.

If a round comprises more than one race, the overall result is counted towards the series prize.

Team prize will be decided by totalling each club's 3 best scores regardless of class at each round. In case of a tie 4th best scores will be counted etc until the tie is broken.

Supporters

Parents and friends are encouraged to attend and are permitted to take photographs. Supporters in boats should take care not to impede competitors and must stay clear of all competitors after the 5min warning.
