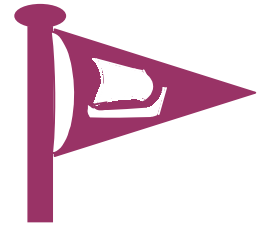




Wayfarer Irish National Championships

Notice of Race

Organised by East Down Yacht Club, Co. Down, and the Irish Branch of UKWA

RULES

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the RYA, the rules of UKWA, the Sailing Instructions (SIs) and this notice of race. ISAF advertising Code Category C will apply.

ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to all boats of the International Wayfarer class. Boats shall be entered by a member of a club, or other organisation, affiliated to a member national authority of ISAF. The person in charge (as defined by RRS 46) shall be a member of a National Wayfarer Class Association. Each boat must have a valid measurement certificate.

REGISTRATION and ENTRY FEE

Registration will be in East Down Yacht Club, on Friday 18th June 19:00 – 21:00, and on Saturday 19th June 09:00 – 10:30.

Race Briefing 10:30 Saturday.

Entry Fee £45-00 / 50-00 Euro includes lunch on the water (Saturday) and soup & rolls on Sunday after racing. Sailing Instructions will be available on registration.

SCHEDULE OF RACES

6 races are scheduled. The warning signal for the first race will be at 12:05 Saturday 19th June. No warning signal will be given later than 14:00 on the last day of the regatta.

COURSES

Details of courses to be sailed will be contained in the Sailing Instructions.

SCORING SYSTEM

The low point scoring system, RRS Appendix A shall apply, except that when fewer than 3 races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third boats overall in the event. Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after racing on Sunday.

LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to during or after the regatta.

INSURANCE

The boat's owner or representative must sign a declaration on the Entry Form that his/her boat is covered by a policy of Third Party Indemnity Insurance of not less than £1,000,000 or equivalent in Euros.
